Referential Fulfillment

Zechariah 9:9

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion!
Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem!

Behold, your king is coming to you;
righteous and having salvation is he,
humble and mounted on a donkey,
on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

Matthew 21:5

Say to the daughter of Zion,
'Behold, your king is coming to you,
humble, and mounted on a donkey,
on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden.'

Referential Fulfillment

2 Samuel 7:12-16

... **I will raise up your offspring after you**, who shall come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom.

He shall build a house for my name, **and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever**. I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son.

When he commits iniquity, I will discipline him with the rod of men, with the stripes of the sons of men, but my steadfast love will not depart from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away from before you.

And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne shall be established forever.'"

to proclaim the year of the LORD's favor,


and the day of vengeance of our God; to



Immediate Context

“See, your house is left to you desolate. For I tell you, **you will not see me again, until you say**, ‘Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.’ ”
